

What does 'no battery is detected' mean on a laptop?

When you encounter the 'No Battery Is Detected' message, it generally indicates that your laptop is unable to recognize its battery. This can manifest in several ways: Your laptop shuts down when unplugged: The device may instantly power off when the charger is disconnected.

How do I fix a 'no battery detected' error on my laptop?

To do this, expand the Batteries category, then right-click your laptop's battery (e.g., Microsoft AC Adapter) and select Properties. If you see text stating your device is working properly, then your battery is fine and the 'no battery detected' bug is likely caused by something else.

Why does Windows not detect my laptop's battery?

Battery drivers on your PC help Windows connect and communicate with your laptop's battery. However, if those drivers aren't functioning properly, Windows may fail to detect your laptop's battery. Here's what you can do to fix that. Step 1: Right-click on the Start icon and select Device Manager from the list.

What if my laptop doesn't have a battery?

If your laptop thinks there's no battery present, perform a full shutdown, unplug the power cable, and physically remove the battery. Then, place the battery back in, reconnect the charging cable, and then power on your laptop.

Why does Windows 11 say no battery is detected?

If the error remains, it could be caused by a corrupted battery driver. In that case, you can try uninstalling the driver instead. Restart your PC after that to allow Windows to install the removed driver again. At times, issues with your PC's BIOS can also lead to the "No battery is detected" message on Windows 11.

How to fix 'no battery is detected' message on Windows 10?

Right-click on the battery adapter and select Disable device. Step 3: Right-click on the battery adapter again and select Enable device. If re-enabling the battery driver does not help, you can try updating it to see if that gets rid of the "No battery is detected" message on Windows. Here's how.
