

How will China's massive solar farm work?

How much solar energy did China add in 2023?

China added 216 gigawatts of solar in 2023, a little over half in large solar farms, according to the country's National Energy Administration. China's total is more than half of what the entire world added last year, according to research from the consultancy Wood Mackenzie.

How many solar panels are made in China?

Four out of five solar modules installed around the world today are Chinese-made. "China's investment in solar really is a gift to the world," says Amit Ronen, director of the Solar Institute of George Washington University. A worker carries a flotation device.
