Can you bring a solar charger on a plane?

Batteries with up to 100 Wh are allowed on planes. However, if your solar charger battery has more than 100 Wh, you'll need special permission before bringing it on the plane. Even if you receive permission, you'll only be allowed to bring batteries with up to 160 Wh on the plane.

Can a solar charger charge a plane without a battery?

If your solar charger has a battery pack, you may connect the battery to a plane's built-in USB port. However, if you only rely on sunlight to charge your gear without a battery, it won't work. It's also vital to check that your charger's battery is compatible with the USB charger you're using.

How many watts can a solar charger charge?

However, most solar chargers come in under the 100 Wh mark. For example, the X-Dragon Portable Solar Charger can charge a laptop and external battery at 40Wh. Many solar chargers are even smaller than this, so while you should confirm the Wh of your solar charger before taking it on a plane, there's a good chance it'll be small enough.

How many Mah can a solar charger have on a plane?

In general, there are regulations on the number of milliamps per hour (mAh) a solar charger with a battery is allowed to have onboard a plane. However, the regulations don't specifically mention the number of mAh that's allowed. Instead, the FAA has limitations on the watt-hours (Wh) a lithium-ion battery is allowed to have.

What should I know before using a solar charger?

While you're charging up your battery, make sure all your necessary adapters and cables are accounted for and that your electronics are good to go. If it's your first time using your solar charger, be sure you know how it works and what to expect.
