

# How long does it take to unplug the power cord when charging the battery

How long does a laptop battery take to charge?

The battery charges in the laptop when the laptop is connected to a power source using the AC adapter. The charge time varies depending on the laptop. If the laptop supports ExpressCharge(TM), the battery typically will have greater than 80% charge after about an hour of charging, and fully charge in about 2 hours with the laptop powered off.

Should I Disconnect my computer from power if the battery is full?

If you are asking if you should disconnect your computer from power once the battery is full, the answer is no. If you do so, your battery will keep discharging and charging. The number of times batteries can be charged is limited and if you unplug your computer every time it is full, it will quickly die.

How often should you unplug a cellphone charger?

So you'd need to unplug a dozen chargers every time you weren't using them for an entire year to save around a dollar. In other words, for a single cellphone charger you'd need to do it would take over a decade of unplugging your charger every time you were done with it to save a buck.

How long does it take a battery to charge?

An exhausted battery will fully charge in about 2 hours and 35 minutes. The battery was not inserted correctly: Unplug the charger and remove and reinsert the battery. The ambient temperature is too hot or too cold: Use the battery charger at temperatures within the designated temperature range (0-40 °C/+32-104 °F).

Should you unplug your device chargers?
