

How to check which factory produced the battery

How do you know if a battery has a production date?

Every battery's production date is etched on to it, usually on a side edge or negative terminal of the battery. The manufactory date contains 4-6 digits on average. However, the production date happens to be a bit tricky. Instead of using plain dates, the manufacturers incorporate code like digits for the production date.

How do I know if a battery has a date code?

Look for a combination of letters and numbers that represent the manufacturing date of the battery. It's important to note that some batteries may not have a date code printed on them. In this case, you can check the battery receipt or contact the manufacturer to determine the manufacturing date of the battery.

How to find the date of manufacture of an automobile battery?

How do you know if a battery is made?

Unfortunately, there is no standard code, but the first two digits usually show the manufacture date. As with the round sticker above, a letter will indicate the month, while the number represents the year. The other characters in the code tell you which factory produced the battery, along with the day and time of manufacture.

How do I know if a battery is old?

In several brands of batteries, the manufacturers place the date of manufacture on the base of the battery, so it is quite difficult to check that date easily, it is indicated in 2 circles with a numbering and a date. Note: This is the date of manufacture of the battery housing. But the battery itself should be about the same age.

How to check manufacturing date of Exide Battery?

Many have inquired about how to check manufacturing date of Exide battery. Here's a simple guide on how to read the manufacture date code for most Exide batteries: The first two characters - the first code is the type of the battery followed by the factory code. You may ignore these two characters.

Find the Date Code: Car batteries have a date code stamped or printed on them. This code indicates when the battery was manufactured. The location of the date code can vary, but it is ...

Not sure if this is right: Battery Date Codes, it's out dated. The code is a string of letters numbers, but all the real information you need is in the first two characters. Usually, the code starts with a letter that corresponds with the month--"A" for January through "L" for December (some manufacturer's codes omit "I"; for them, "M" indicates December).
