

# Why does the lithium battery keep flashing

Why is the charge light flashing?

The CHARGE light may flash for the following reasons: The environmental temperature is too cold to charge the battery pack. The battery pack has not been used for a long time. There is a poor connection between the battery and charger. There is a problem with the battery pack.

What are some common problems with lithium-ion batteries?

Why does the charge lamp flash so fast?

There is a problem with the battery pack. The CHARGE lamp may flash fast (multiple times a second) or slow (around 1.5 second intervals), depending on the cause. Slow flashing occurs if the battery has not been charged for a long time or if the environmental temperature is not suitable for charging the battery.
