

What happened at a lithium battery factory in South Korea?

A lithium battery factory in South Korea was set on fire after multiple batteries exploded on Monday, killing 22 workers, most of them Chinese nationals, fire officials said.

Did a building explode in Yonhap?

Large chunks of the building appeared to have been blown out into the street by the explosion. The operation continued overnight to find the missing worker, with fire authorities pressing 100 personnel and two rescue dogs on Tuesday to expand the search, Yonhap news agency reported.

What happened at a lithium battery factory in Hwaseong?

Firefighters carry a body at the site of a fire at a lithium battery manufacturing factory in Hwaseong (AP) Mr Kim said the high intensity of the fire has made it difficult to identify and rescue those inside the warehouse. It was difficult to enter the site of the explosion initially "due to fears of additional explosions".

What happened at a Korean battery plant?

The bodies of the victims were recovered from the second floor of the plant, where the fire erupted. The second floor was allotted for inspecting and packaging finished battery products. The identities of only two Koreans among the victims have been confirmed so far while others were burnt beyond recognition, authorities said.

What happened at a burnt battery factory in Hwaseong?

They found human remains and personal articles, which will be DNA tested for identification, Hwaseong fire official Kim Jin-young said.
